Simulation & Surgical Skills Training

Simulation/skills sessions will occur monthly during protected Friday morning didactics.

These will include:

- **Obstetric simulations such as** shoulder dystocia, postpartum hemorrhage, eclampsia, operative vaginal deliveries and OASIS lacerations.
- **Gyn Simulations such as** IUD insertions, hysteroscopy, D&C, vaginal hysterectomy and laparoscopic simulations including Essentials in Minimally Invasive Gynecologic Surgery (EMIGS).

Research

Over the course of training, residents will be expected to take part in a quality improvement project and an original research project. These projects will be presented at the Departmental Grand Rounds at the end of the academic year as well as the AdventHealth Orlando GME Resident Research Day.

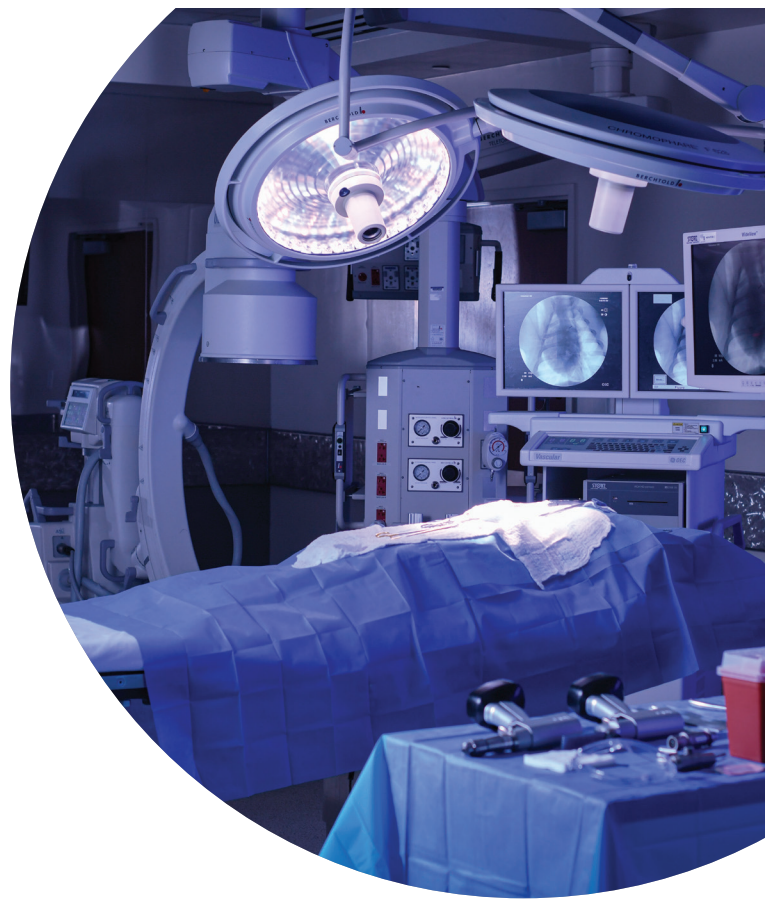

Teaching Sites

The AdventHealth for Women and AdventHealth for Children hospitals are home to the OB Emergency Department, Labor and Delivery, antepartum and postpartum inpatient care, and a Level 4 NICU. Gynecology surgical services are performed in the main hospital or Sherman Outpatient Surgery Center, which are attached to the women's and children's hospitals.

The outpatient clinic is housed within the AdventHealth Medical Group Orlando OB/GYN office at 235 East Princeton Street, Suite 200, Orlando, Florida 32804

Medical insurance: Family medical insurance is provided free of charge through the AdventHealth insurance plan along with prescription coverage.

Vision and Dental: Available, institution and resident/fellow share cost.

Life insurance: Life insurance, equivalent to one year's salary, is provided free of charge. Additional life insurance may be purchased for a minimal charge.

Vacation/personal time: Trainees receive 20 days for vacation/personal time off each year. 5 additional days are allowed for CME travel to conferences/board review/boards.

Uniforms: Residents receive two white coats in their first year of training. Hospital scrubs are provided at each campus in the OR locker room.

Meals: Residents receive a daily meal credit.

Parking: Designated physician parking is free at all locations.

Education/CME Reimbursement: Residents receive \$1500 max in education/CME reimbursement per academic year for select items.

Rotation Schedule

Our residency program curriculum provides training that will allow graduates to pursue a full-scope generalist practice with substantial exposure to all subspecialties if a subspecialty fellowship is desired. All rotations are six weeks long.
