

AHS LAUNCHES NEW ENTERPRISE LIBRARY

In March of 2018, Adventist Health System launched a new enterprise library that provides all 46 facilities access to a full service electronic library complete with clinical and medical resources and expert medical librarians. The AHS Library is accessible on every facility intranet page located under the "Employee Resources" tab.

The AHS Library is fully electronic with over 700 journals including core journals such as all JAMA publications and The New England Journal of Medicine. We offer access to knowledge-based information databases such as PubMed, Ovid, Clinical Key, Clinical Skills, Lexi-Comp, CINAHL, and UpToDate and provide mobile access to UpToDate and Clinical Key.

The AHS Library Discovery search tool offers a single unified platform to search content across all our books, articles, media, and other research materials. The flexible interface also places a premium on user's ability to refine searches to their individual needs. And, if advanced searching is needed or you would prefer for someone else do it for you, please contact the medical librarians. We are here to serve you!

As a highly integrated health system, sharing a single network, there is greater attention towards institutional subscription and copyright stewardship. Therefore, we ask clinicians to please not use personal resources or resources from affiliated colleges and universities especially when sharing content with colleagues across the system. The AHS Library can provide just about anything you need. Also, the AHS Library resources can be enjoyed for your convenience from the office or home when you access the network remotely.
