
## LETTER FROM THE CEO

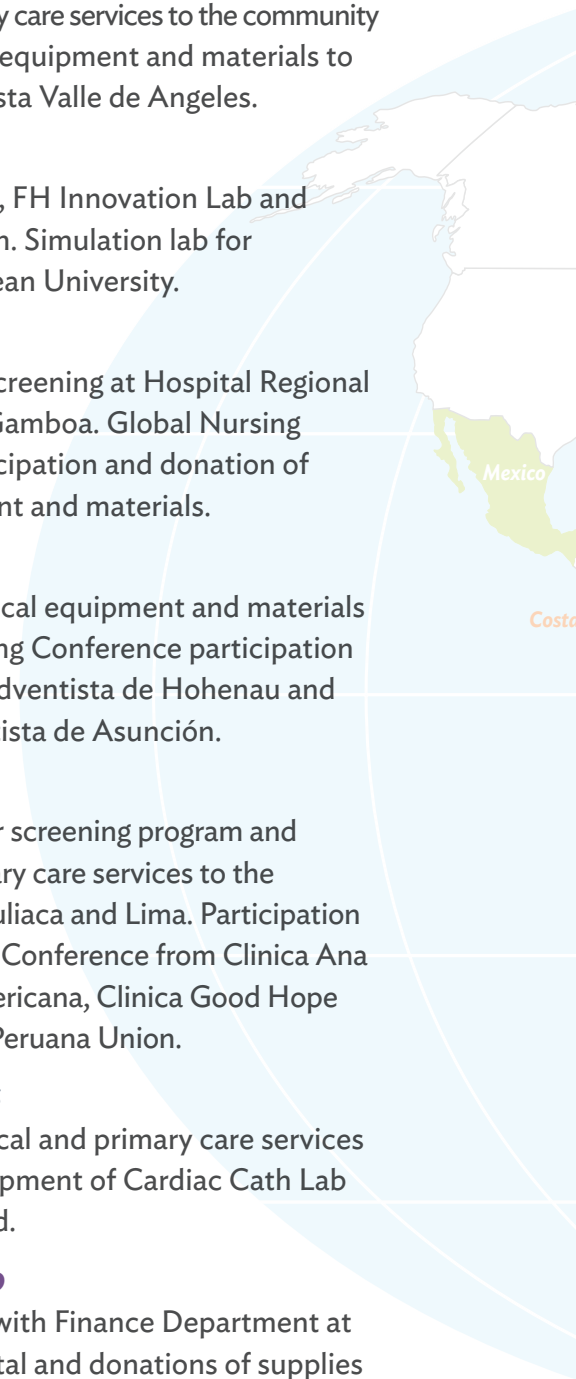

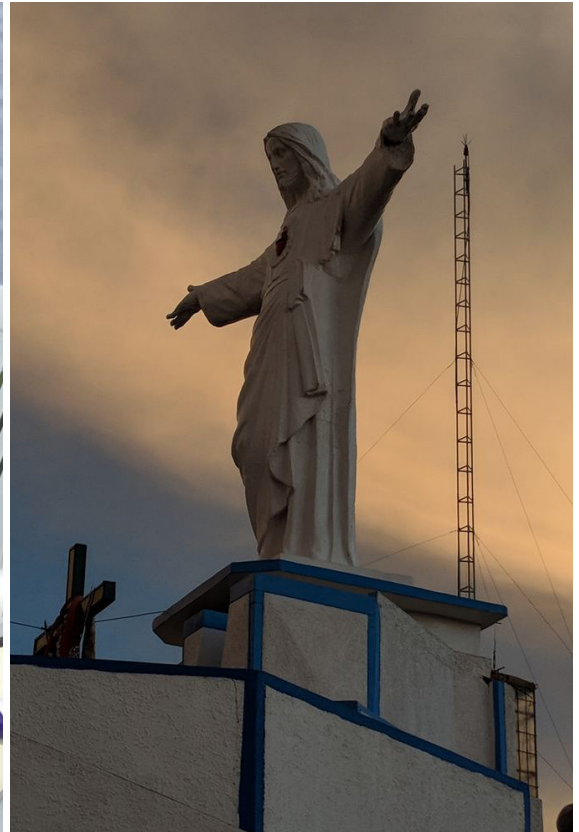


# PERU MISSION TRIPS

# HAITI MISSION TRIPS

Since the earthquake in 2010, AdventHealth has established Haiti Adventist Hospital as a Footprint location. Through a series of projects, we have supported ongoing health care access, infrastructure development and humanitarian assistance to the people of Haiti.

Through our **Operation Sunshine** program in Haiti, AdventHealth University physical therapy students, pediatric residents and other volunteers provided health care to over 500 children living in 10 orphanages and children’s homes. Our goal is to measurably improve the health of these children. Haiti Adventist Hospital provides care when the children become sick. Another partner, My Neighbor’s Children, is committed to improving their education, shelter and food security.

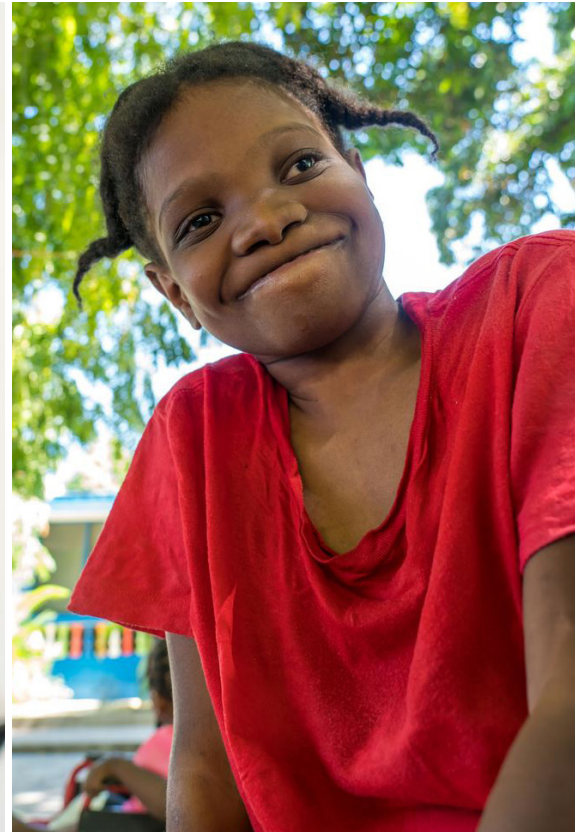

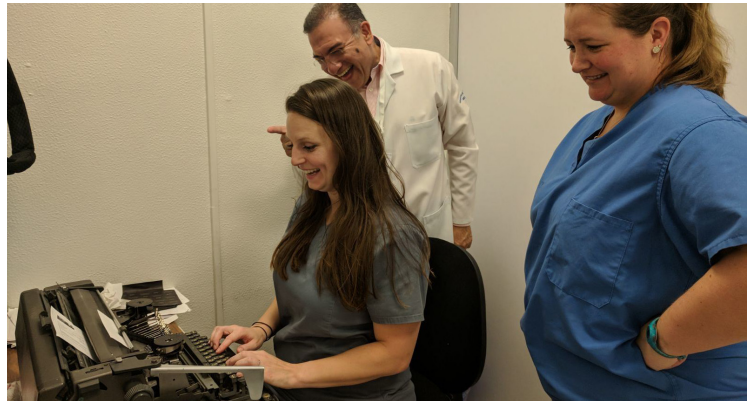
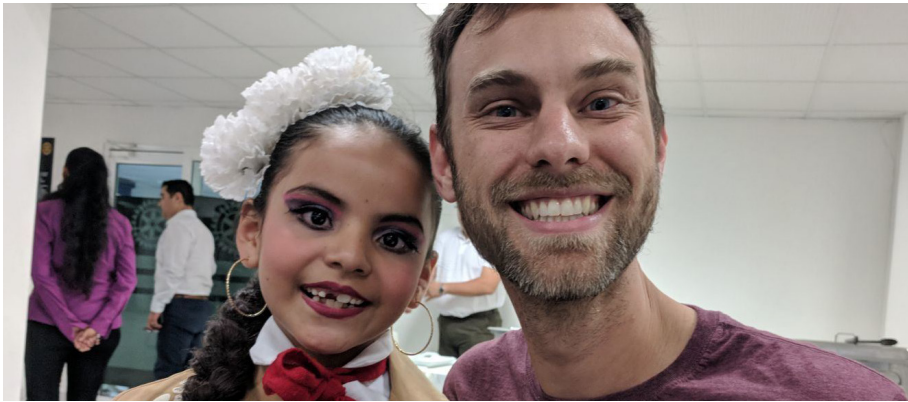

# MEXICO MISSION TRIP

For several years, AdventHealth Global Missions has supported the AdventHealth Family Medicine Residency and Women’s Health Fellowship in their work to improve health outcomes for women in rural areas. Since 2005, the medical team has provided care to over 2,000 indigenous Mexican women, with the goal of making a lasting impact on screening and treatment for cervical cancer. The medical care includes colposcopies and colposcopic exams, cryosurgery, LEEPs, treatment of all gynecological infections, and provision of antibiotics and vitamins.

# PHILIPPINES MISSION TRIP

In the Philippines, a Footprint location since 2015, AdventHealth Global Missions works in tandem with Adventist Medical Center – Manila to provide free surgeries, consultations and primary care to underserved communities in the Metro Manila area. In 2018, our largest group of volunteers traveled to Manila to conduct primary care clinics along with surgeries. Our volunteer medical team was comprised of surgeons and physicians from AdventHealth hospitals in Florida and Kansas, as well as Kettering Medical Center in Ohio. Our volunteer group also included health care professionals from Adventist Medical Center - Manila and a hospital in Guam.

# ETHIOPIA MISSION TRIP

One of our earliest established Footprint locations, Ethiopia’s Kalala Learning Village has seen much growth throughout the years with the help of AdventHealth initiatives. The Kalala Learning Village welcomed our missionary team at the Summit Clinic, a health care establishment located within Kalala that serves the people in the community and the school.

Our volunteer group of physicians, nurses and other health care professionals on this trip had the opportunity to care for school children as well as people living in the surrounding communities. Our care team included an optometrist who fitted people with prescription eyeglasses and made it possible for them to see clearly again.

# OPERATION SUNSHINE



The Operation Sunshine program continues to thrive in its mission and purpose under the clinical leadership of Dr. Stacy McConkey and Dr. Catherine Loe, which is to provide health care to children living in orphanages. Working alongside My Neighbor's Children — a Florida-based non-profit group — orphanages and group homes have been identified to participate in this program, with 500+ children

enrolled to date. In 2018, three teams of volunteers traveled to Port-au-Prince, Haiti, to conduct annual medical checkups for kids and provide physical therapy in February plus hemoglobin testing, vision screening and fluoride treatments for their teeth in May and December.

Throughout the year when our volunteer teams are not present, if the children become ill they are received at Haiti Adventist Hospital and provided health care, including physician consultations, medications, laboratory tests and even

hospitalization if necessary. The care provided to the children is supported by fundraising, and donations received for Operation Sunshine reimburse Haiti Adventist Hospital for medical costs.



# CONTAINER REPORT

As equipment and supplies are removed from service at AdventHealth, our Global Missions team is able to place these materials with our partner institutions to support their efforts. Materials have included beds, stretchers, bedside tables and recliners, a cardiac cath lab for Jamaica, infant warmers, and other medical supplies and equipment.

# 5TH GLOBAL CONFERENCE FOR NURSING EXCELLENCE – LATIN AMERICAN EDITION

AdventHealth and AdventHealth University welcomed 38 nurses from six different Latin American countries for our Annual Nursing Conference. The conference covered an array of topics focusing on learning and education plans. It was an opportunity for our nurses to connect with peers from different countries, expand their knowledge, and focus on the pursuit of nursing excellence.

Each year the Nursing Conference rotates between an English-language and Spanish-language format. This year with the help of AdventHealth's Interpreter Services team, our nurses were able to receive simultaneous translations throughout the presentations. Some highlights of the conference included the AdventHealth Nursing Education Department discussion of learning and education plans, our CREATION Health team's introduction of their REST of Your Life program, and a Nursing Skills Fair that covered topics such as safety and falls prevention, nurse phlebotomy and 5-step wound management.
