

## **WORKSHEET: Closure Criteria**

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This worksheet is used by staff to determine whether a study or site can be closed.

(P)

All criteria in 1 must be met. The criterion in 2 must also be met for studies subject to federal oversight other than FDA.

- 1. For all studies (see Footnote 1)
- 1.1 The protocol is permanently closed to enrollment
- 1.2 All subjects have completed all protocol mandated interventions and interactions (see Footnote 2)
- 1.3 All protocol mandated collection of identifiable private information about the subjects is complete
- 2. For studies subject to federal oversight other than FDA
- 2.1 Analysis of private identifiable information is completed (see Footnote 3)
- 3. Notes
- 4. Footnotes
- 4.1 For closure of a site, the questions refer to the site. For closure of a study, the questions refer to all sites
- This includes interventions and interactions related to collection of long-term follow-up data, including final visits and any follow-up activities (such as phone calls, post-card contacts, or long-term follow up required by the protocol)
- 4.3 This can be checked even if another organization (e.g., statistical center, sponsor, or CRO) will analyze private identifiable information from subjects
