Researchers need to account for applicable IRB Review Fee(s) in their proposed budgets. IRB fees will be submitted to Accounting monthly and are non-refundable. If you are unclear regarding whether a submission will be charged, please contact the IRB office.

Exceptions

IRB Review Fees will not be charged for the following:

- Research <u>fully and directly</u> funded by grants where AdventHealth is the only site(s), including:
 - Federal government, State of Florida and its local governments <u>unless</u> permissible per grant agency, per study
 - Non-profit foundations including the AdventHealth Foundation
 - NOTE: Excludes Industry Grants
- Unfunded research study designed solely for an academic activity where the resident, fellow, student or learner plays a vital role in the design of the study and will have publication privileges. These will be subject to IRB review on a case-by-case basis.
- Determination Requests
- Non-research use of a Humanitarian Use Device (HUD)
- Emergency use of a drug or device
- Single Patient IND requests
- Compassionate use of a device
- Promptly Reportable Information
- Investigator Brochures
- Closures

*Late submissions – IRB submission where the study team is requesting (in writing) review at an IRB meeting having not met the submission deadline date for that meeting. Late additions to an agenda must be reviewed/cleared by the IRB Office.

*†*Internally funded studies are those where there is no external funding for the study (The study will rely on AdventHealth internal operating funds for support.)

t†Consent Revisions and Recruitment / Retention Materials will be charged at the IRB's discretion.

Reliance Consultation & Confirmation Services

- Reliance agreement negotiation with each site
- Communication and coordination with the Human Research Programs (HRPs) at each site
- Reliance documentation procurement

Initial Site Review

- Site-specific protocol and supporting documents review
- Site-specific informed consent review (unlimited number of documents)
- Recruitment material review (unlimited number of documents)
- Site-specific community and institutional considerations

Ongoing sIRB Review

- Amendment reviews
- Continuing/annual reviews
- Reportable problem and event reviews
