Medical/Surgical Staffing Model

The <u>Medical/Surgical staffing model</u> is a framework for staffing the care of patients during the COVID-19 pandemic surge. Contingency and crisis staffing models for three phases (conventional, contingency and crisis) are provided for use, depending on the number of experienced RNs and other staff available.

Staffing models for <u>physicians</u>, <u>RNs and respiratory therapists</u> were also created and shared in the April 7 Clinical Brief.

Redeployment Toolkits

Redeployment toolkits are designed to aid in the education and onboarding of staff for specific roles during the COVID-19 pandemic. <u>These toolkits</u> are available for RNs (acute care and non-acute care), respiratory therapists and patient assistants. Please share with your clinical leadership team and deploy as needed.

For the RN and based on training time available, you may select rapid onboarding or a one- to three-day orientation timeframe to develop additional skills.

When ordering COVID-19 PCR tests for patients who are currently in the ICU, or will be going to the ICU from the Emergency Department (ED) or another clinical area, please use the "Coronavirus 2019 PCR ICU" in iExtend so the lab can prioritize the order for processing.
