Cloth Face Masks

The safety of our team members is our top priority. When PPE policy indicates the use of an **ear loop face mask or surgical mask**, a cloth face mask cover may be worn **over the mask** at the team member's own discretion. Cloth masks **alone** are considered Tier 3-locally sourced and are not approved at this time.

As a reminder, team members should only be using Tier 1 PPE at this time, until otherwise directed by the System Command Center.

- Tier 1 Commercially available, clinically certified PPE
- Tier 2 AdventHealth-approved, commercially produced, non-certified PPE
- Tier 3 Locally sourced masks (only use when Tier 1 and 2 aren't available)

PPE Policy Amendment — Universal Masking

The Universal Masking announcement in the April 2 Clinical Brief has been updated in the SOP PPE Policy.

- Team members and medical providers in clinical venues will be issued a face mask and are expected to wear the mask at all times unless more than six feet from another person and at meals. Distribution of other PPE will be based on team member role.
- For team members in non-patient care areas, the decision to wear a mask will be made at a facility or divisional level.

COVID-19 Testing Priority

Please immediately notify your providers that there is significantly increased testing available through your hospital lab using MicroGenDX for symptomatic patients in all tiers of testing. Providers should order "Coronavirus 2019 PCR Sendout" test.

This might now allow drive-by testing of **symptomatic patients** referred by community physicians. Please connect with your hospital lab for collection processes. Ensure appropriate collection of sufficient patient information and referring physician information so that results can be provided.
