Increased COVID-19 Testing Availability

Increased COVID-19 Testing Availability

It is extremely important that AdventHealth take advantage of the large capacities of COVID-19 tests now available from MicroGenDx to test **symptomatic patients** through AdventHealth facility labs.

Actions needed now:

- 1. Accelerate communications to providers, including ambulatory providers, of the increase in testing capacity.
- 2. Collect sputum/phlegm/saliva. This process has been simplified. Please see the MicroGenDx instructions.
- 3. Immediately implement ability for centralized testing of symptomatic patients, such as drive by testing.
- Coordinate collection, packaging and procedures with in-house lab. The test is orderable as Coronavirus 2019 PCR Sendout. Order and results interface will be live Monday, April 6.

5. Ensure test identification and follow-up notification plan for patients and referring providers.

It is urgent that we take advantage of this increased testing capability now. AdventHealth Clinical will closely coordinate with Supply Chain and will communicate the testing availability per day to each division. Division ICC's will need to coordinate testing in their Division.
