PCR Testing Orderables for iExtend and iConnect

These new education materials contain information on the iExtend and iConnect Cerner changes:

- "Provider Update COVID Status" Order for iExtend and iConnect: This order affords
 physicians the discretion to change the COVID Status on the Cerner Banner Bar,
 recognizing they have a full clinical picture of the patient. For example, if a COVID-19
 test was ordered and returned as "not detected" but the physician was still suspicious
 based on symptoms, the Banner Bar display could be changed from "negative" to "PUI."
 - Communicable Disease Screening Form (found within the iExtend document linked above): The Communicable Disease/Personal Health History Form completed by the nurse has been updated to include COVID-19 testing done outside our facilities in order to display that information on the Cerner Banner Bar. Information regarding the iConnect Communicable Disease Screening Form is here.
- COVID-19 Anticoagulation Pathway PowerPlan changes for iConnect and iExtend: COVID-19-positive patients are hypercoagulable and at-risk for thrombosis. The anticoagulation treatment algorithm guides physicians in use of prophylactic anticoagulation to reduce these untoward events.

Power Plans in <u>iExtend</u> for Concentrated Insulin: A small cohort of critically ill COVID-19 patients in the Central Florida Division – South Region (CFDS) had requirements for greater than 100u of IV insulin/hr. Glucommander is unable to support a rate that exceeds 100u of IV insulin/hr, and the fluid requirements with the standard concentration of insulin (1 unit of insulin per 1 ml of IVF) exceed the desired volume for patients with ARDS. This PowerPlan is unique to CFDS Critical Care and provides a concentrated insulin drip of 5 units/ml and a manual algorithm for rate adjustment. See education for embedded Cerner calculator here.
