Clinical leaders are providing frequent updates to all clinicians in an effort to keep you current about AdventHealth's response to COVID-19. The following topics are included in this brief:

- Ophthalmic Procedures Recommendation
- CDC Screening Question for Signs and Symptoms Updated

## **Ophthalmic Procedures Recommendation**

As ophthalmologists resume surgical practice, we are providing additional guidance during the current pandemic. The scientific community along with AdventHealth Clinical have provided specific guidance for ophthalmologists as they resume operations.

#### Recommendations:

- Routine PCR testing prior to surgery
- Use Povidone-iodine disinfection for endonasal lacrimal and orbital procedures
- The personal protective equipment (PPE) risk stratification based on ophthalmic procedure and COVID-19 test result is as follows:
  - Use standard surgical PPE for surgeon if the patient is COVID-19-negative and undergoing a <u>low-risk procedure</u>
  - Use N95 respirator if the patient is COVID-19-positive or untested due to procedure being urgent or emergent
  - Use N95 respirator for <u>high-risk procedures</u> (such as aerosol generating procedures) regardless of test result
- An interval of 20-30 minutes between cases

## **CDC Screening Question for Signs and Symptoms Updated**

In late June 2020, the CDC added four additional signs and symptoms to their screening list for COVID-19. The additional signs and symptoms include:

- 1. Fatigue
- 2. Congestion or runny nose
- 3. Nausea/vomiting
- 4. Diarrhea
